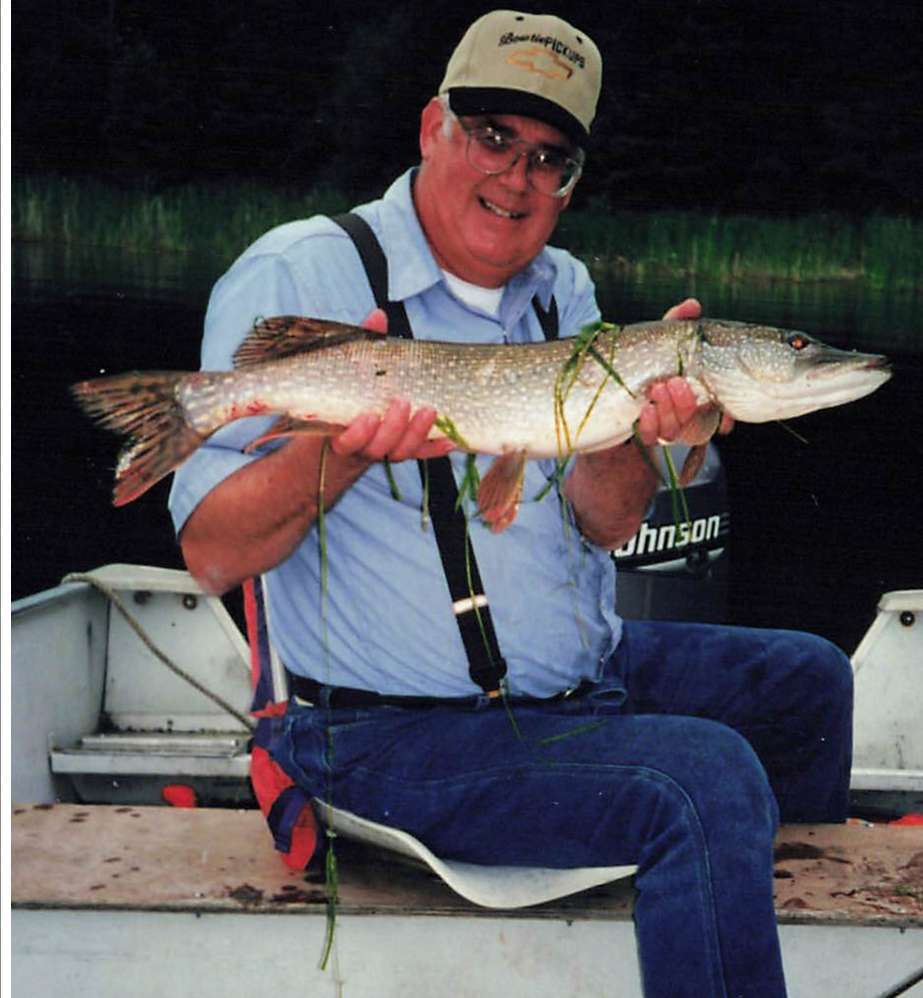

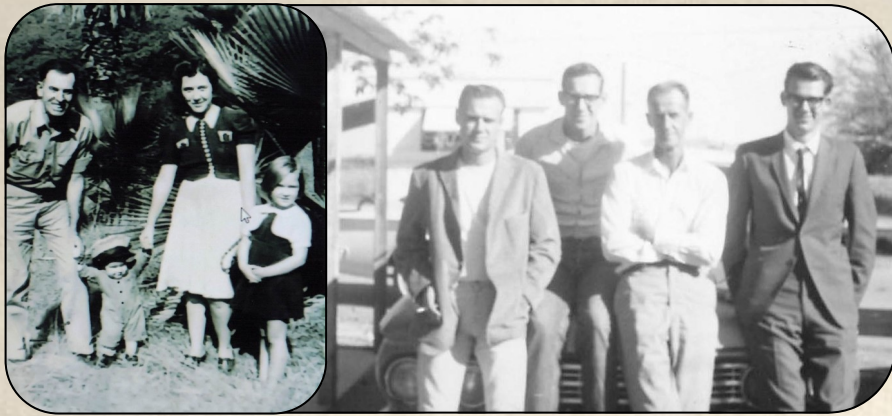

1944 - 2026





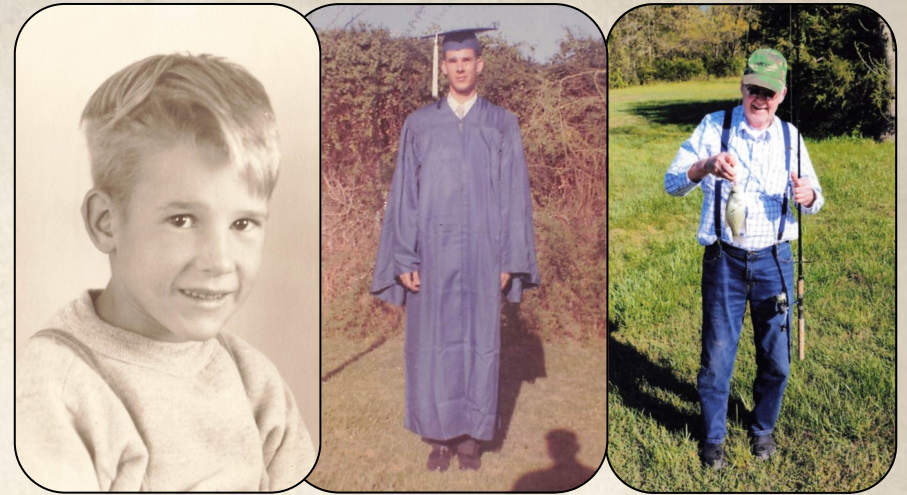
Tony Ray Silvers, son of the late Clarence & Faye (Smith) Silvers, was born on October 15, 1944 and departed this life on April 20, 2026.
