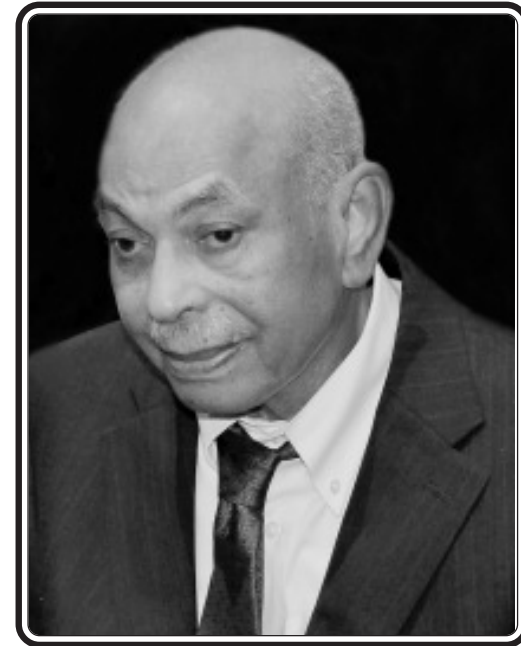

Obituary

Warren L. Albert, 82, of Neptune, New Jersey passed away in Watkinsville, Georgia on March 19, 2017. He was born in Long Branch, New Jersey on May 4, 1934 to Charles and Alverda Albert.
