Lillian also enjoyed playing bingo and looked forward to trips with family and friends to Wendover, Nevada, and Deadwood, South Dakota, where she could try her luck and enjoy good company. She will be remembered for her generous spirit, her welcoming home, and the many handmade treasures and baked treats she lovingly shared with family and friends. More than anything, Lillian cherished her family. She took great pride in watching her son Craig compete in sports and later found immense joy in following the activities and accomplishments of her grandchildren, Elizabeth, Charlie, and Rebecca. Whether attending games, performances, or other events, she was one of their biggest supporters. In recent years, she delighted in watching her great-grandchildren grow and become the next generation of her family's story. Her greatest happiness came from spending time with her family and celebrating their milestones and successes. Lillian was preceded in death by her parents, Carl and Amanda Peterson; her beloved husband, Jim Wollman; her sisters, Phyllis Jalbert, Frankie Morlock and an infant sister Alice Margaret Peterson.
