

# Life's Reflections

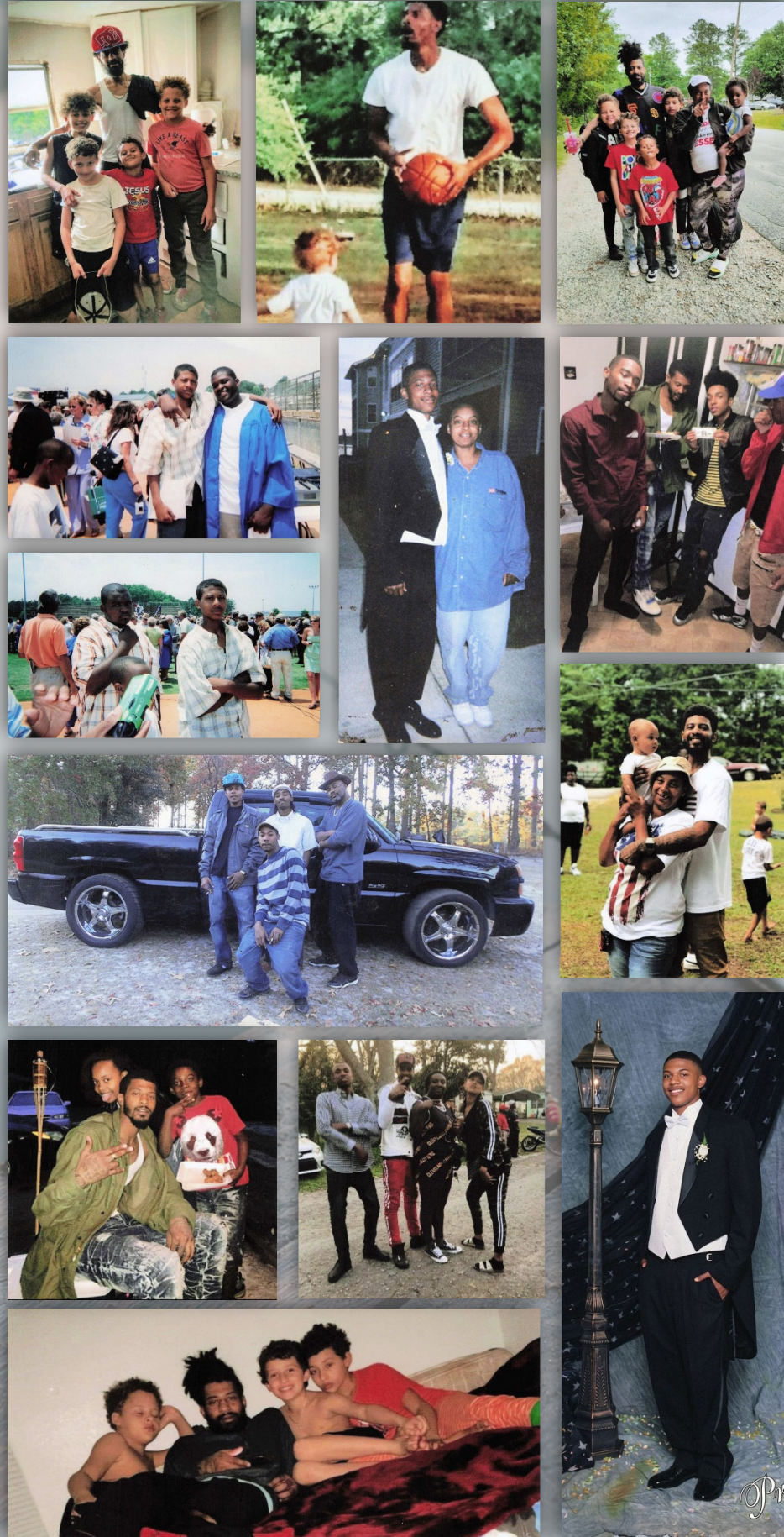
