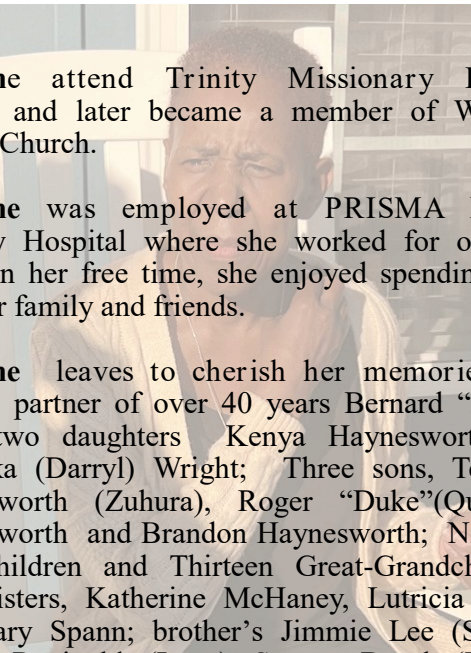
**Angeline** attend the public schools of Sumter County and was a proud graduate of Sumter County Adult Education earning her high school diploma in 1996.
