A TIME TO PLANT | ECCLESIASTES 3:2

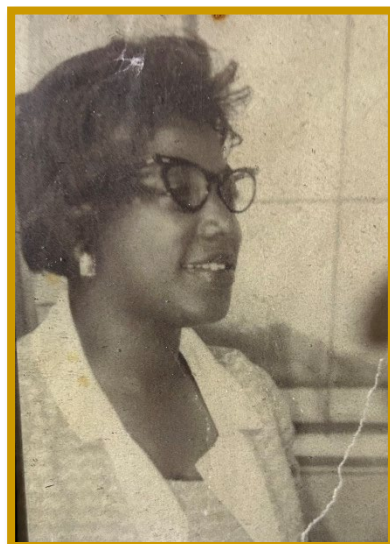
