

A Sainted Legacy

On March 24, 1942 a son was born to Mr. Smithie Sr. and Mrs. Bernice Bogany-Wright, whom they named Freddie B Wright, in Swartout Texas. Freddie received his education at Dunbar High School, in Livingston Tx, where he graduated. He was reared in the church and Accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age at New Hope Missionary Baptist Church. Later in life He was ordained as a Deacon at New Hope Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Isaiah Prophet Hunt and became the chairman of the deacon board for a number of years. He worked faithfully as the Sunday School Superintendent for many years. He later joined the St. Luke Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Keith Johnson. On August 30th 1963, he married the love of his life Dorothy Mae Carter and to this union five children were born. They reared their children in the church and taught them the love of God. He loved his family and would do whatever He could to show that love.



He is known for his great faith in God. Freddie B Wright was an excellent provider to his family. He started his career at the Leggett Lumber Company and was promoted to Asst. Manager at Duke City Lumber Company and He retired at the Batson Mill. He later partnered with his son Richard and joined the Logging business until his health began to decline. He was inducted into The Texas Football Hall of Fame this year for the excellence he exemplified on and off the field but



We'll be united...evermore!




