The life symphony of Johnny O'Brannon Norman began in Greenwood, SC, on July 12, 1980, composed by the late Mr. Johnny Cade Norman and Mrs. Cathy Ann Norman. He was an avid fan of the ACC's Miami Hurricanes and the NFL's Dallas Cowboys.
