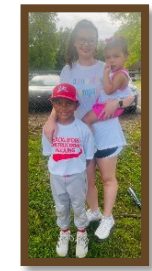
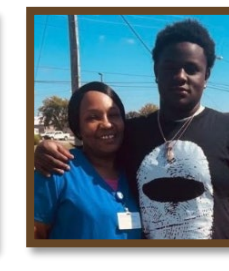
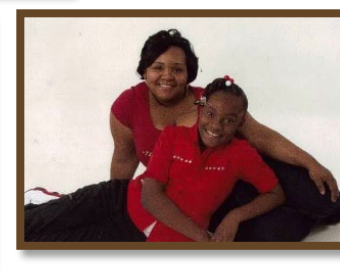
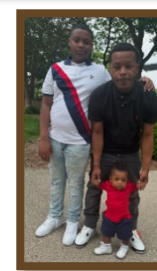
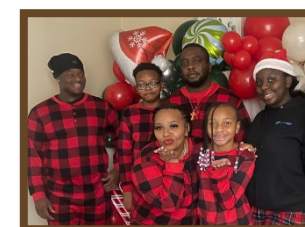
TRIBUTES OF LOVE
