DANIEL VIDAL WAS BORN ON AUGUST 31, 1957, IN MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN, WHERE HE WAS RAISED. HE SPENT HIS FINAL YEARS IN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AND PASSED AWAY PEACEFULLY ON MAY 19, 2026, AFTER A LONG AND COURAGEOUS BATTLE WITH KIDNEY DISEASE. DANIEL LIVED A LIFE DEEPLY ROOTED IN FAITH, FAMILY, AND AN UNWAVERING DEVOTION TO GOD.
