SALEM — Anthony “Nino” Rizzotti, age 92, of Salem passed away on Tuesday July 13, 2016. The son of the late Stephen and Jenny (Femino) Rizzotti, he was born and raised in Salem and graduated from Salem High School in 1941. Upon graduation he joined the United States Navy and fought in World War II. He later worked for the Salem Police Department as their custodian for over 35 years before his retirement.
