# REGINALD'S STORY

Reginald Wigfall, affectionately known as Reggie, Regy, and “Gremlyn” to his family and friends, was born on June 23, 1970, at Brooklyn Jewish Hospital in Brooklyn, New York. He was the firstborn child of Mr. John “Pop” Wigfall and Mrs. Harristine Wigfall. On Thursday, May 1, 2025, Regy peacefully entered eternal rest at his brother’s home in Huger, South Carolina.

Regy was educated in the public school system of Brooklyn, NY. From an early age, he was introduced to the love of Jesus Christ through his involvement at the Historic First Church of God in Christ. There, he participated in Sunday School, Sunshine Band, and Purity Class. As he grew in faith, he served faithfully on the Usher Board and the Media Team, among other ministries.
