Charles Edward Owens, 53, of Malvern, AR. passed away on March 29, 2026 at Baptist Health Medical Center in Malvern, AR. He was born in Malvern, AR and raised in Tulip, AR.

Sgt. Owens began his career with the Arkansas Department of Corrections in October of 1996 as a Corrections Officer at the Cummins Unit. In 2002, he moved to the Pine Bluff Unit where he was promoted to Corporal in 2003. In 2005, he moved again and was promoted to Sergeant at the Ouachita River Correctional Unit. He then moved to the Benton Unit in 2007, and shortly thereafter, he moved to the Wrightsville Unit. In 2009, Sgt. 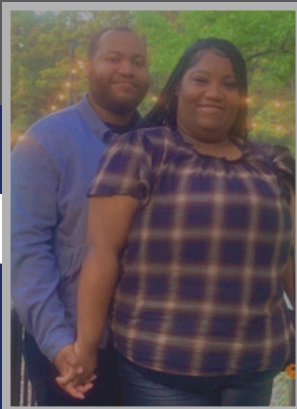
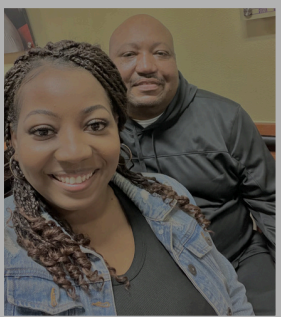
