She received her Bachelor of Science degree from Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio and continued her studies until she obtained her master's degree in elementary education. Her special love was teaching children special needs, which she did for many years. Additionally, she was a foster parent for many years to numerous children. She also served as a volunteer for Georgetown Life Squad and in her younger years performed other community service projects through her affiliation in the Order of the Eastern Star.

Helen loved farming, gardening, and horses. She enjoyed watching her horses from her kitchen window and had a passion for plants and flowers, which was evidenced by the beautiful foliage and blooms in and around her home.
