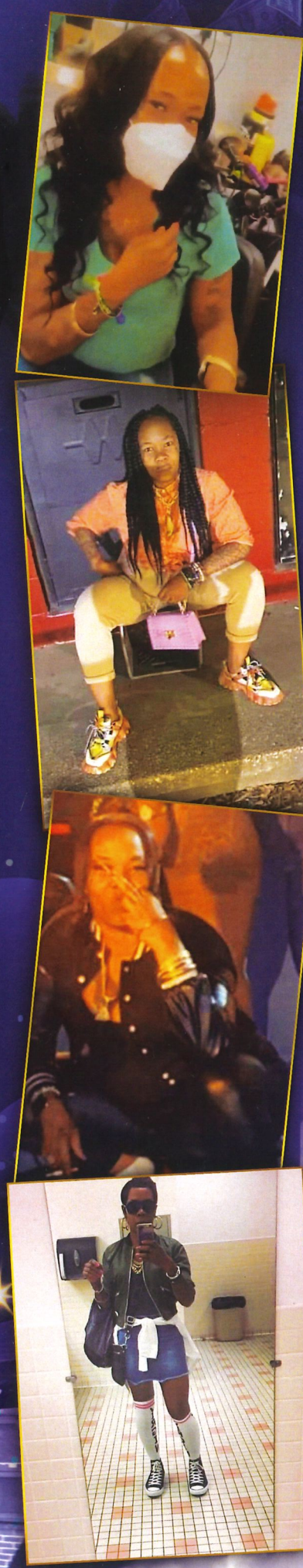
Towanda LYLES
