dwell in the house of the Lord for ever.*



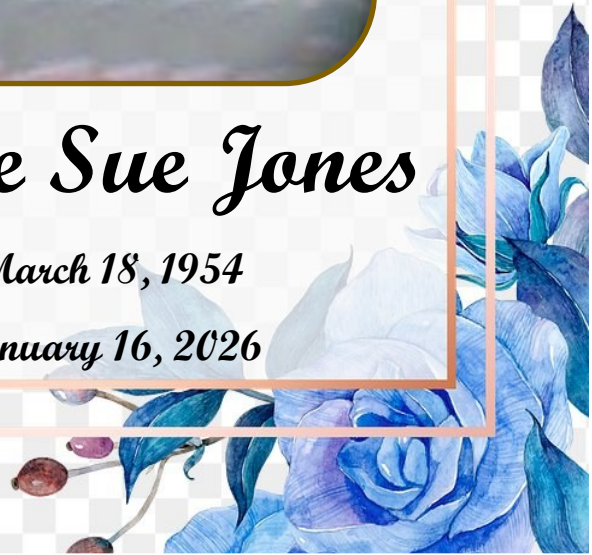
