Throughout his career as a Contract Manager, Joseph made significant contributions to his field while maintaining a warm and humorous approach that endeared him to colleagues and clients alike.

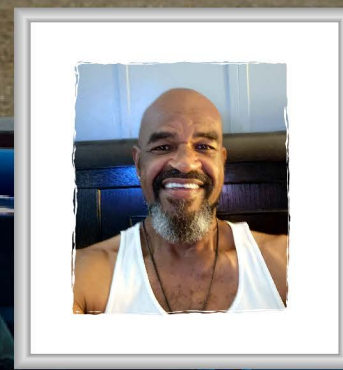
