




Afterglow

Charles “Chuck” Edwin Watts, age 85, of Dillsburg, died on Thursday, October 23, 2025. Charles was born on Sunday, September 1, 1940, in Harrisburg to the late John Edward Watts and Edna Irene (Vaughn) Watts. Charles was the widower of Sarah Marie (Snyder) Watts, who died on February 4, 2006. In addition to his parents and wife, Charles is preceded in death by his daughter: Tina M.
