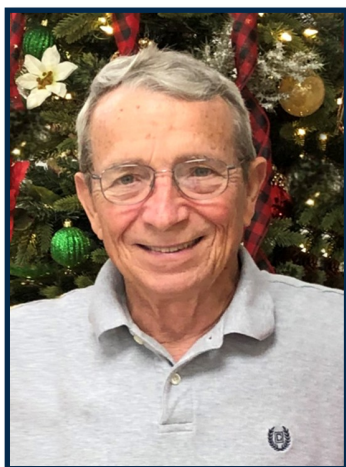

William Denny Faust, 79, of Newport, North Carolina, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 26, 2025, at the Crystal Coast Hospice House.
