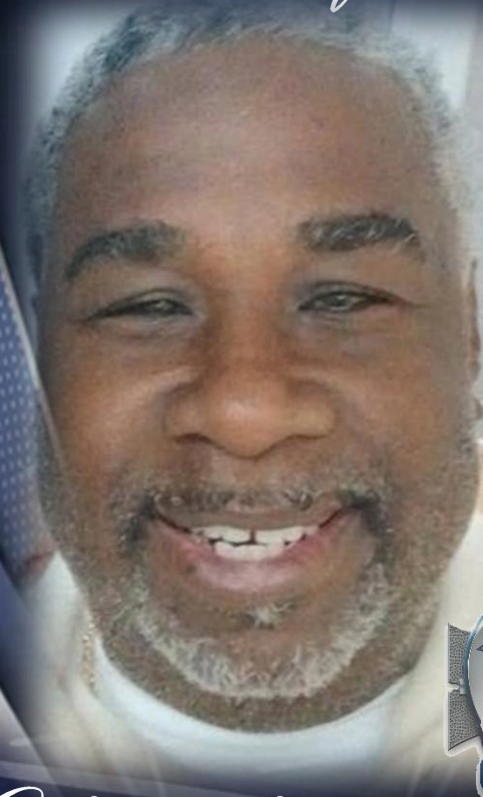


Loving God,
