my cup runneth over.

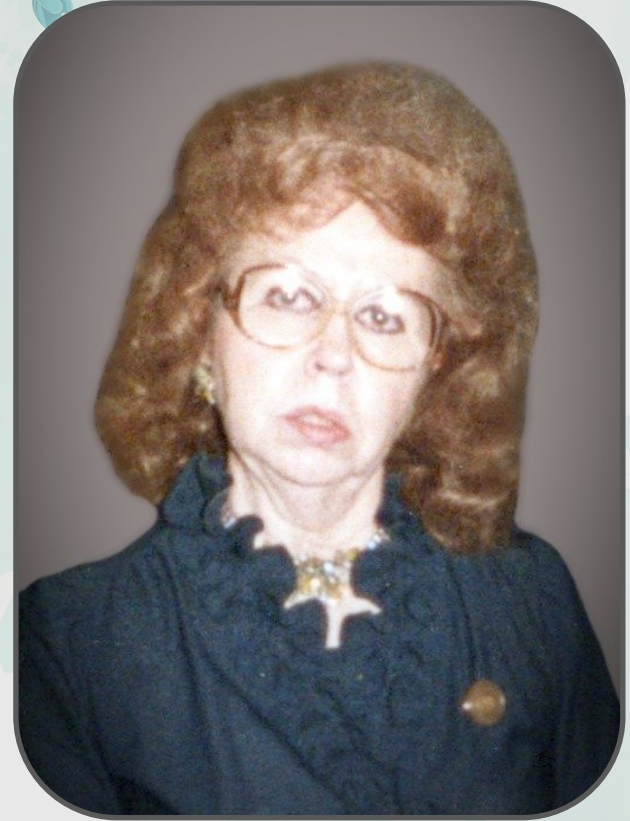
6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all
