I'm resting in Him

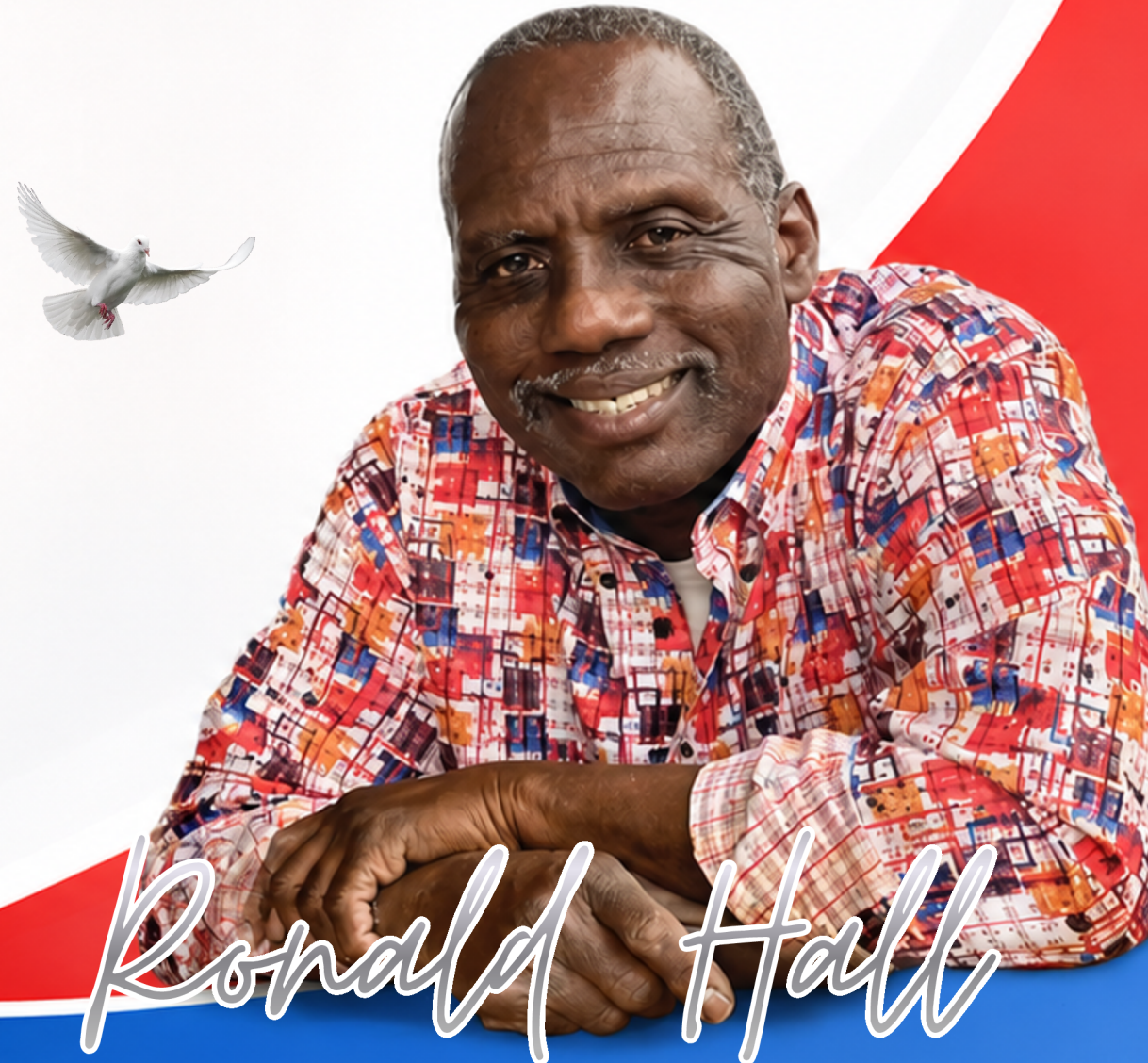
