Will forever guide us on our way.

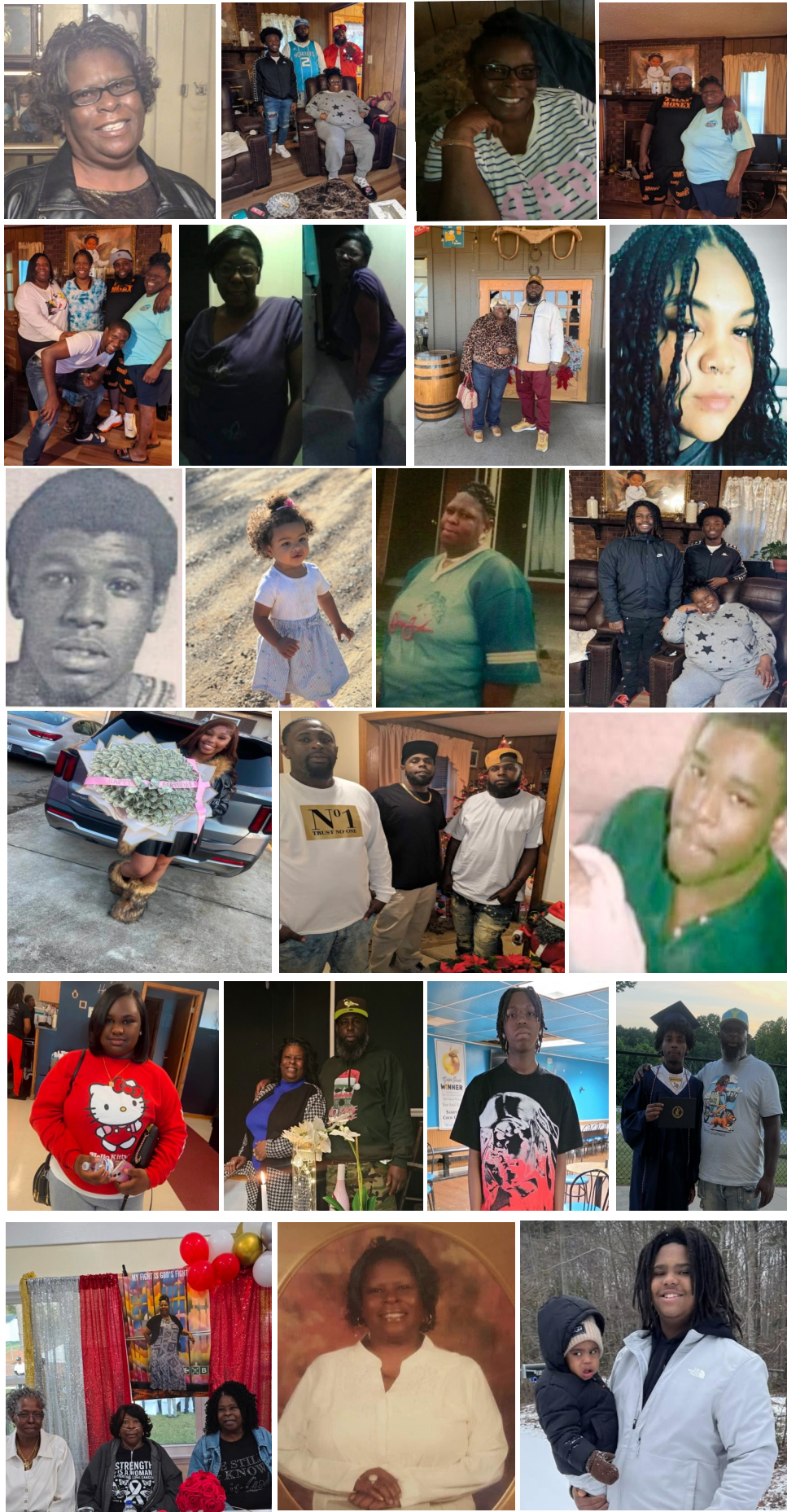
Though our hearts are heavy with sorrow,
