 Love, Charma



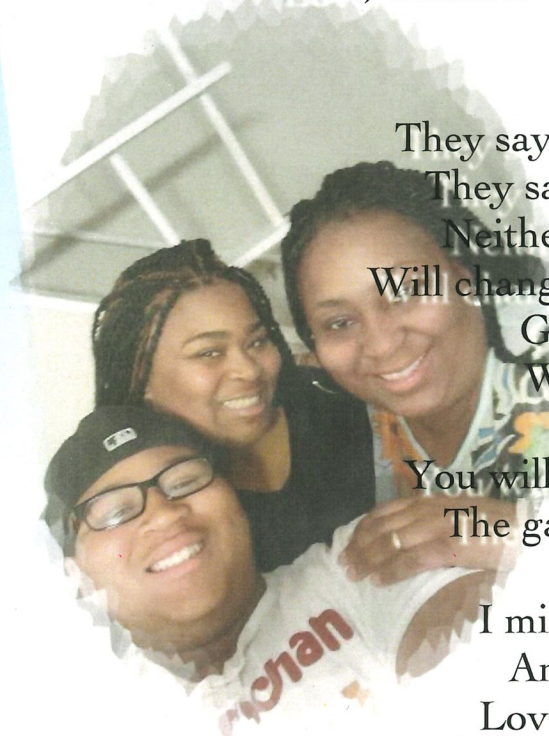
