The Obituary

Paulette Chappell-Warren, 73, a longtime resident of White Plains, peacefully departed this life on August 27, 2025. Paulette was born on July 16, 1952 to Cornell and Elizabeth Chappell in Amelia Court House, Virginia.

After graduating from Amelia County High School in 1970, she continued her studies at Virginia State University and graduated with a Bachelors of Science in 1974.

After graduating, Paulette relocated to White Plains, NY where she began working as the Director of the White Plains CAP Pre-K Program, UMOJA. In August 1977, she began her career in Human Resources with the Westchester Community Opportunity Program, where she dedicated 41 years of service. For 34 of those years, she served as Human Resources Director, a role she cherished and excelled in.

Paulette was an active member of the White Plains Student Aide Society, which provided scholarships to students in need, as well as a member of the Greenburgh-White Plains Chapter of the Westchester Black Women's Political Caucus, Inc.

Paulette married Larry Warren in 1977 and poured her heart into raising their two sons, Ahmad Warren and the late Larry-Jamaal Warren. Even though she wasn't a big sports fan, she never missed the chance to cheer them on, faithfully showing up at games and events with pride and encouragement. Her love for her children was constant and unconditional. When Ahmad chose a career in law enforcement, Paulette's initial worries soon turned into deep pride, and she stood firmly behind him as one of his greatest champions.

Paulette was passionate about life and loved to spend time with her many friends and colleagues. Paulette's true passion was being a mother to her children and instilling in them the confidence and love that her son Ahmad still carries with him today.

Paulette dedicated her life to Christ and joined Bethel Baptist Church in September of 1993 and served faithfully there until she no longer could. She was truly a beacon of light who lived to inspire everyone she knew to do their best and to live a righteous life.

Paulette was predeceased by her father, Cornell Chappell, and son Larry-Jamaal Warren. She is survived by her son, Ahmad Warren, daughter-in-law, Tia Warren, mother, Elizabeth Chappell as well as her brothers Cornell Chappell Jr., Kenneth Chappell and Ronald Chappell.
