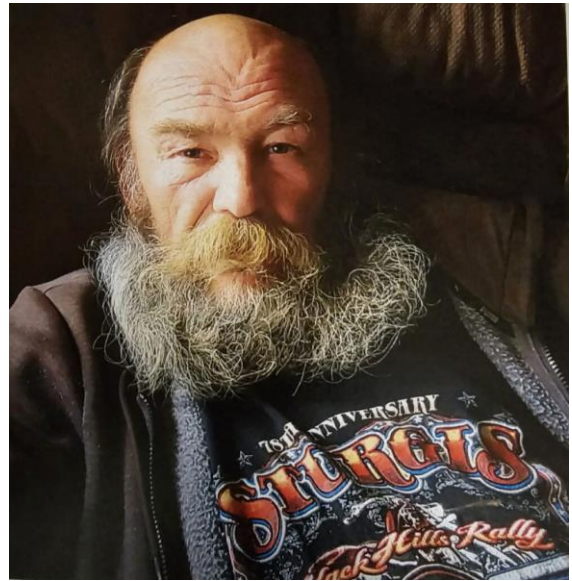


***A Fisherman's Prayer***
