Obituary

PROTHO WAYMON, JR. WAS BORN ON JULY 1, 1935, AT JEFFERSON HOSPITAL IN PHILADELPHIA TO PROTHO WAYMON SR. AND EUNICE WORKMAN WAYMON. HE WAS THE TENTH OF ELEVEN CHILDREN.

PRO, AS HE WAS AFFECTIONATELY CALLED, ATTENDED THE PHILADELPHIA PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, WHERE HE WAS AN EXCELLENT STUDENT AND MENTALLY GIFTED. PRO WAS AN AVID READER AND HISTORY BUFF.

AT THE AGE OF SIXTEEN HE JOINED THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE. AFTER EXCEPTIONALLY HIGH-TEST SCORES, THEY WERE AMAZED THAT HE WAS THE ACTUAL TEST TAKER. THE MILITARY AFFORDED HIM THE OPPORTUNITY TO TRAVEL TO MANY COUNTRIES AND SEE MANY PARTS OF THE WORLD. HIS MILITARY EXPERIENCE TAUGHT HIM DISCIPLINE, HE GAINED KNOWLEDGE, AND THE ABILITY TO COMMUNICATE WITH ANYONE ON ANY LEVEL. HE WAS A GREAT DEBATER AND CHALLENGING HIM WAS AT YOUR OWN RISK.

WHEN **PRO** WAS EIGHT YEARS OLD HIS MOTHER JOINED THE CHURCH OF THE LIVING GOD PILLAR AND GROUND OF THE TRUTH UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF PROPHET F.S. CHERRY. PRO WAS A GUARD AND ACTIVE PARTICIPANT IN THE CONGREGATIONAL LESSONS. HE WAS A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING AND BECAME A TRUSTEE. **PRO** WAS CARING AND UNDERSTOOD THE MEANING OF CHARITABLE GIVING IN ANYONE'S TIME OF NEED. HE LOVED CHILDREN, OFTEN INTERACTING WITH THEM.

HIS ONLY SON PRECEDED HIM IN DEATH. **PRO** LEAVES HIS FAMILY AND FRIENDS TO MOURN HIM. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS SIBLINGS, NORMAN GUNTHER AND HIS SISTER JEAN WAYMON THREADGILL, AND HIS GODSON, AARON DIXSON, A HOST OF NEPHEWS AND NIECES AND HIS CARETAKERS TRIFINIA ADAH REGUSTERS, AND JAMES ROBINSON.
