


Daughter of Debra Elizabeth Hooks and Rickey Augusta Brandford was born on July 26, 1970. She received her wings on April 20, 2023.


Shawntale was educated by Baltimore City Public Schools where she graduated from South Western High School and continued her education at ITT Tech.

Love From Your Daughters


