From a young age, R.P. had a passion and talent for soccer, playing for several club teams in Amarillo. His love for the game was reflected in his energy, and joy in being part of a team.

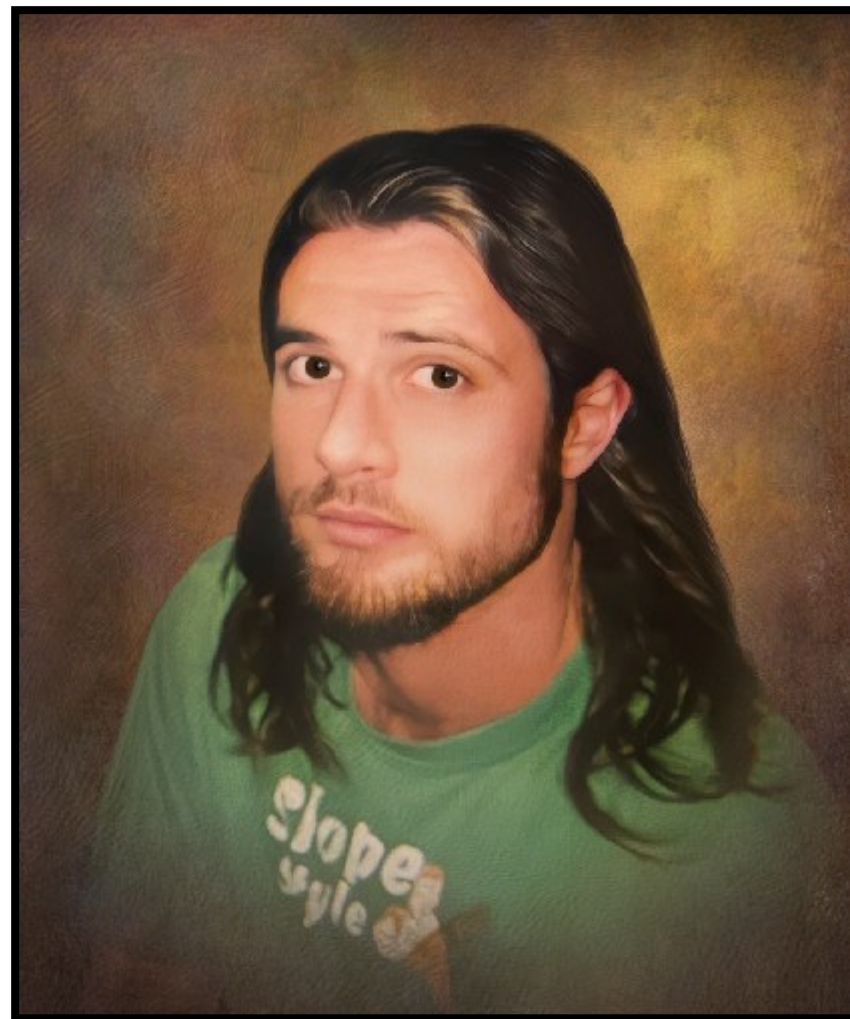
