

Wilburn Dwyane Dennis went to his heavenly home on Wednesday, September 18th, 2024. Dwyane was born July 26, 1937 in Abilene, Texas, to parents Wilburn and Beulah (Dearing) Dennis. Dwyane was raised in Texas and Oklahoma and found his calling in life as a minister at a very young age. Dwyane delivered his first sermon at just 13 years old. Following God's plan for him, Dwyane traveled and spread the word of God in many churches across the United States, including the Oakcrest Church of Christ in Oklahoma City, OK, the University Church of Christ in Canyon, TX, the Broadway Church of Christ in Paducah, KY, the Baytown Church of Christ in Baytown, TX, and, most recently, the Central Church of Christ in Shawnee, OK. Dwyane loved Christmas traditions: decorating the family tree; searching for the perfect outfits to surprise Marcia; and being the first to say "Christmas Eve Gift" to the family in hopes of getting something extra.

Dwyane is preceded in death by his parents, Wilburn and Beulah Dennis; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Bud and Corinne Todd; and many dogs including his 3 beloved Scottish Terriers.
