Before her career choice had been made, Citizen National Bank offered her a position and her life in the business world began. As a young Mother, she worked parttime in offices during their busy season. After 24 years, Mavis retired as Wahpeton's City Assessor.

Mavis married Bill Enochson on September 18, 1954 at Immanuel Lutheran Church. Over the years, she served as church secretary, organist, and even as a council member.

Mavis and Bill were a good team. They supported each other in their family life and in the community. They were always willing to help friends and relatives. Their home was a welcoming place and often the site of extended family gatherings. Mavis loved to make Christmas special.

In 1981, Bill Enochson died unexpectedly and Mavis was a widow for 24 years. In 2005, Mavis married Bill Hamann, a friend from her youth. After his death in 2021, she moved to the Leach Home.

Her fingers moved quickly over piano and organ keys, on the typewriter and computer, and at the sewing machine.
