He knew His masterpiece was completed, And so, He called it....."DaD"



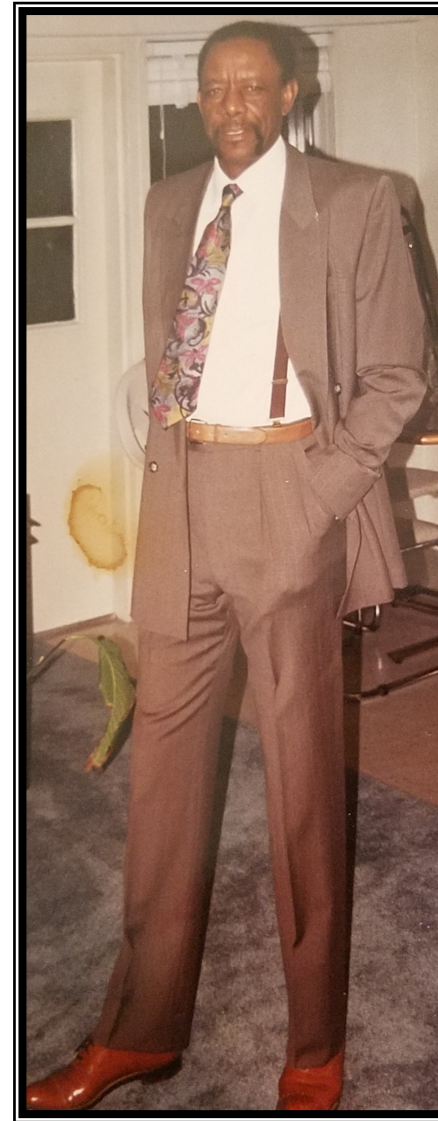
