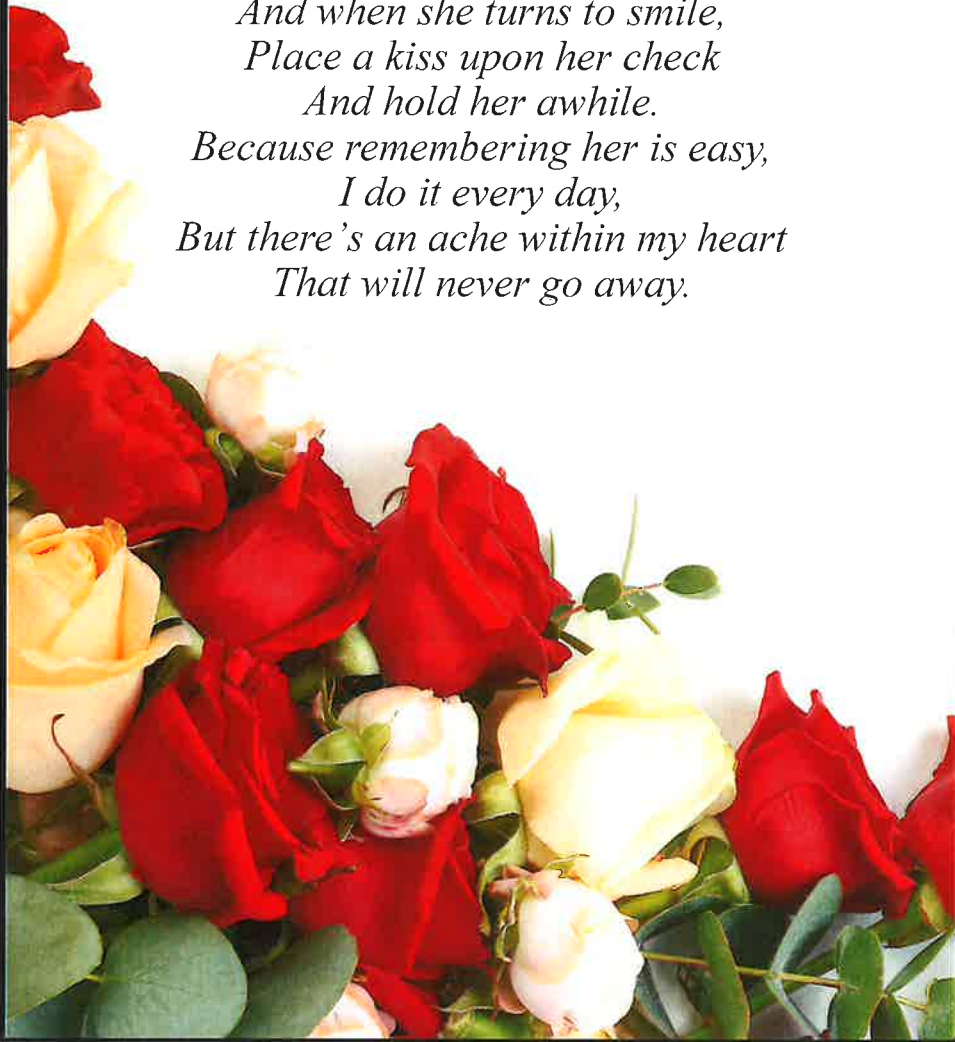


If Roses Grow in Heaven
