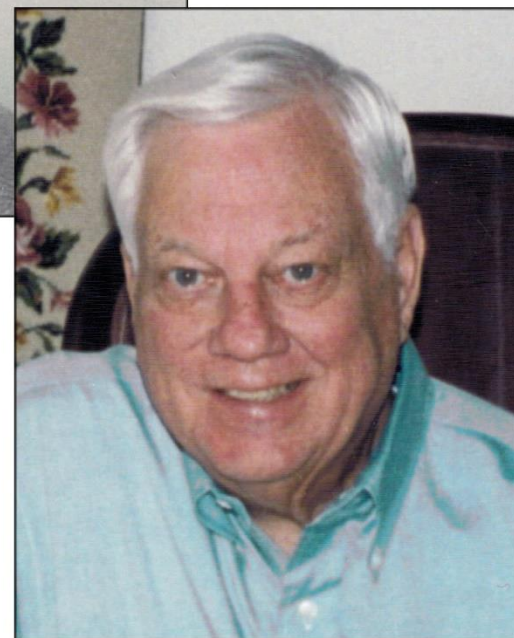


Dad's Testimony
