staff they comfort me.*

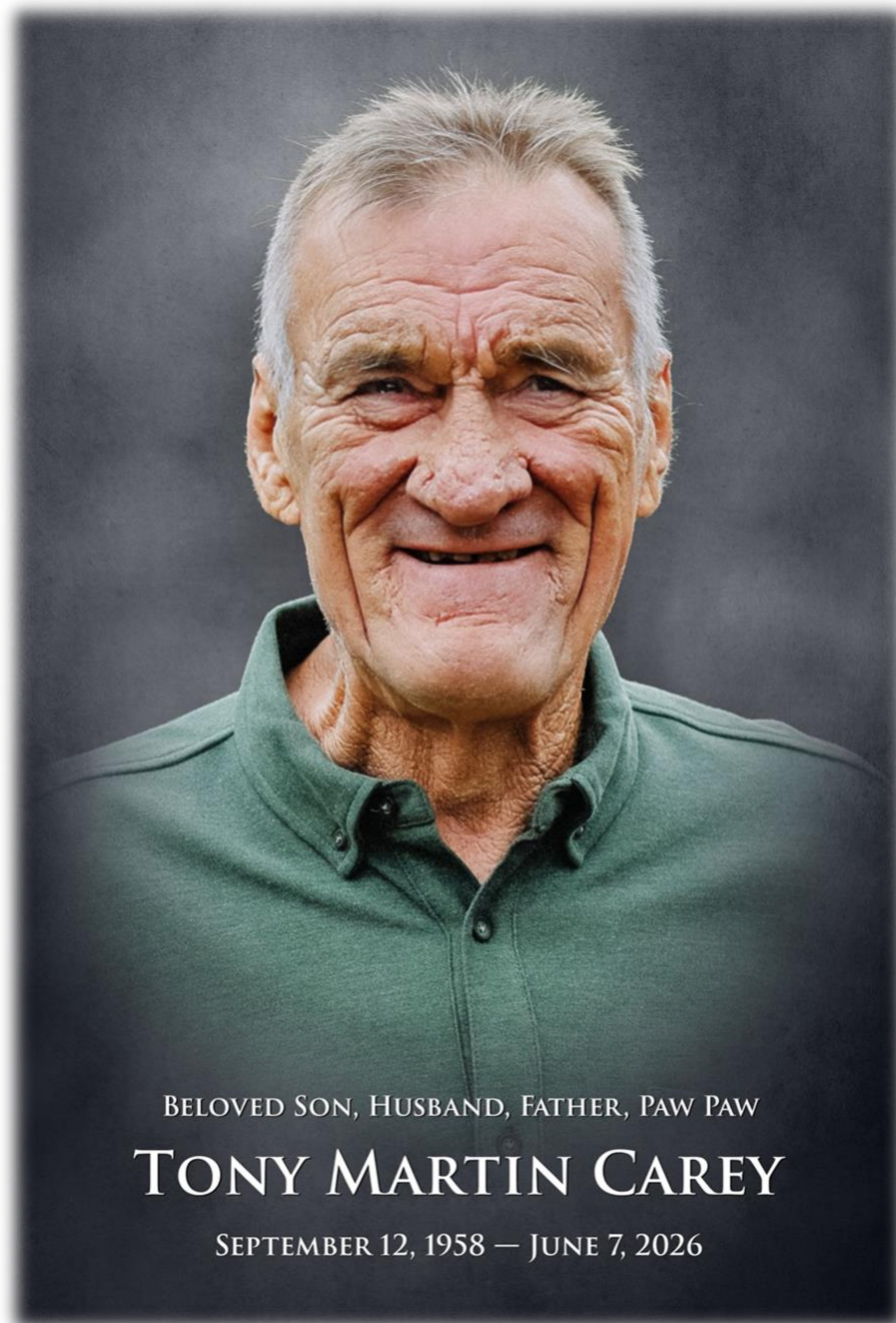
