Robert B. Reed, 60, of Columbus, Ohio, passed away peacefully on November 5, 2025.

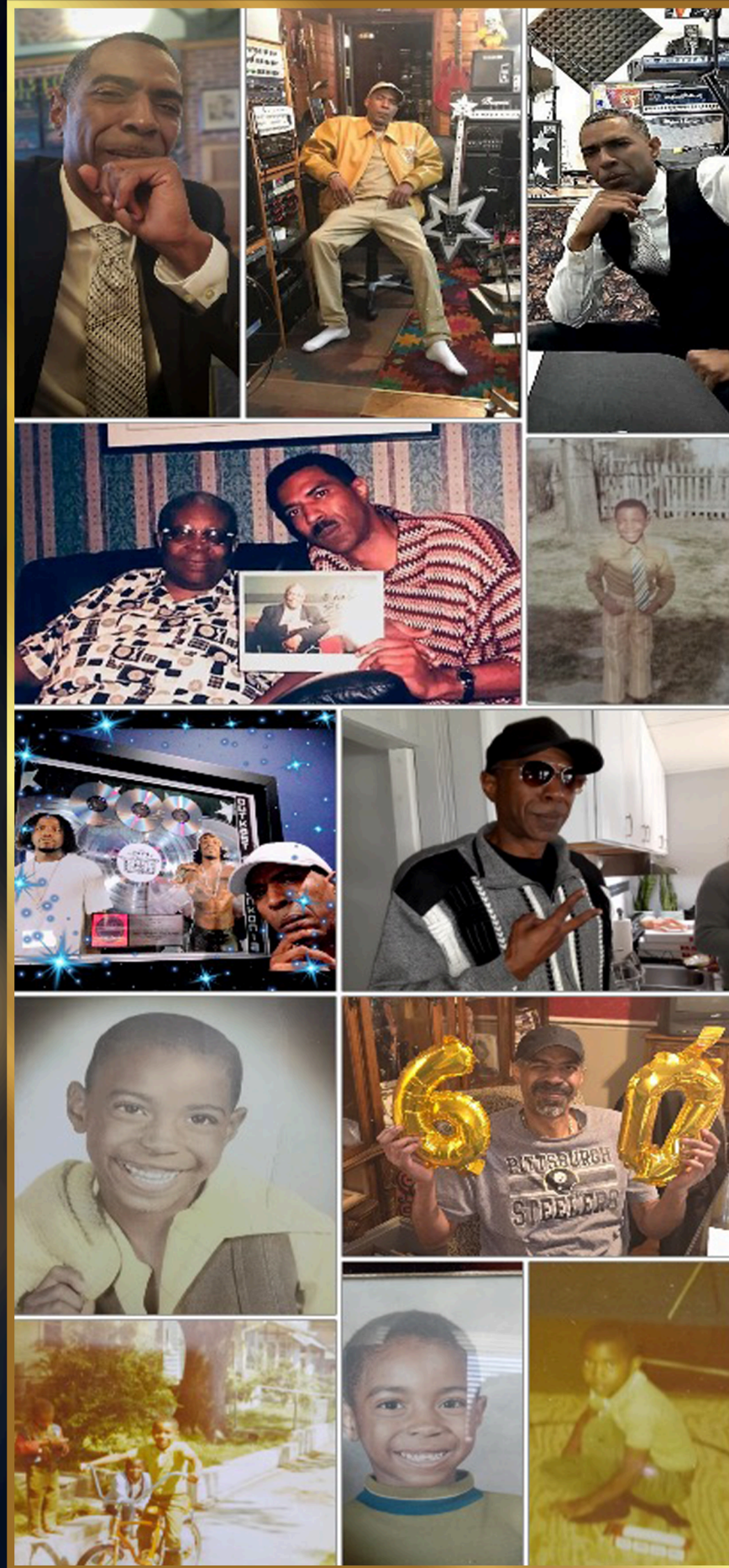
