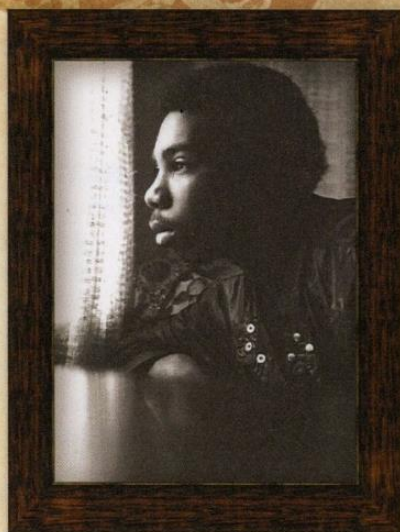
Over the years, Nate was employed at the Coatesville VA Medical Center, Giant Market, and Harrison House Senior Living.

In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by one sister, Juanita Rivers, and two brothers, Thomas Towles and Herbert Brown.

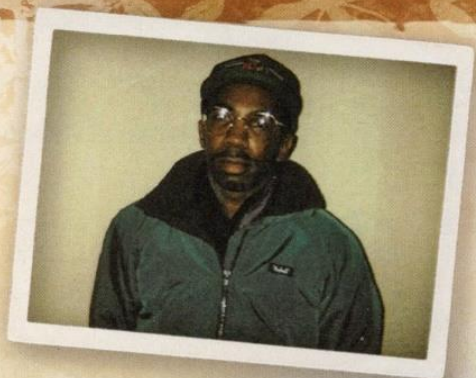

Broken Chain

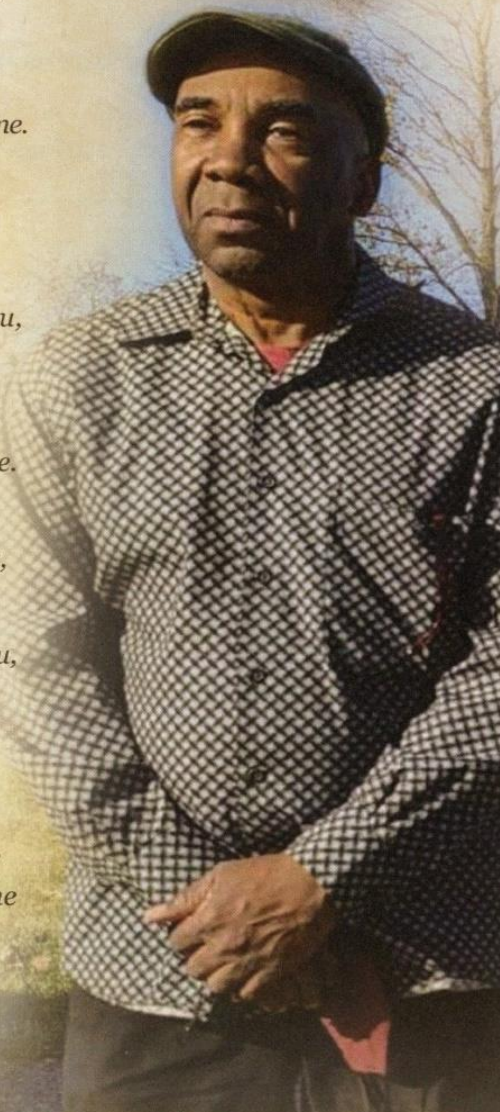
*We little knew that morning

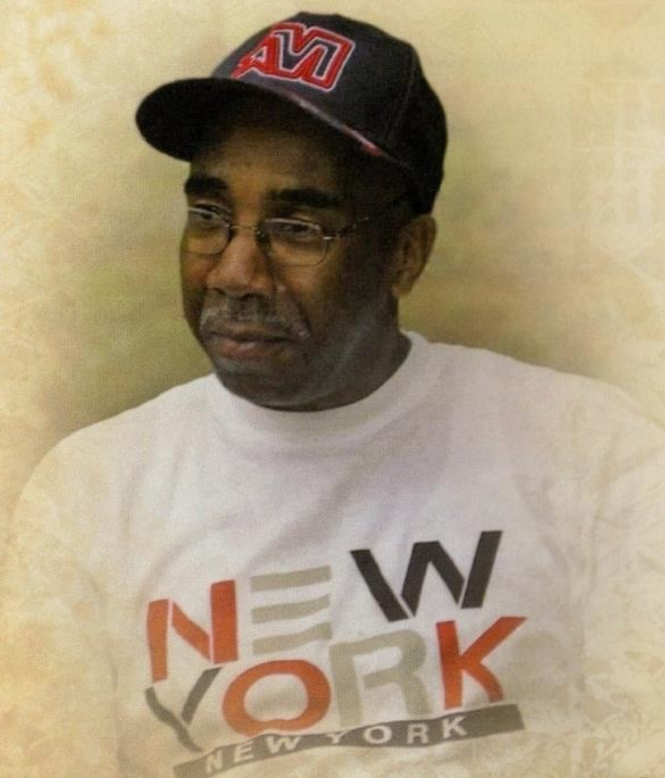
