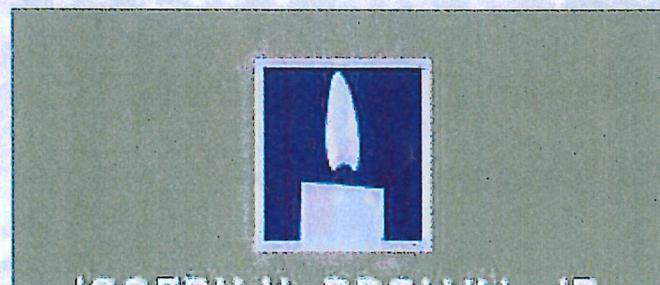

Remembering Antoinette

Antoinette (Tonie) Vondaleah Gaylord-Edwards was born to the late James Gaylord Sr. and Viola D Porter. Antoinette was born on August 4, 1965, and the Lord called Antoinette home to her final resting place in Heaven on November 17, 2022, after brief illness.

Antoinette was educated through the Baltimore Public School system until receiving her High School Diploma from Model Secondary School for the deaf in 1985 located in Washington D.C. She then proceeded to Gallaudet University where she completed two full years until her rare bone disease caused her too much pain to continue.

A short time later, She became pregnant with her first-born child Tiondre D Jenkins in 1988
In 1994 Antionette began working at The United States Postal Service and remained there for 13 years.

With 10 years of Tiondre being her only biological child, in August of 2000, Antoinette gave birth to her only girl and final child Tymira S Edwards from her union with her soul mate Tyrell M Edwards.
Antoinette also cared for Deaf and intellectually disabled adults at Emerge Inc. and community support services for the Deaf up until the present.
