Her Life

ADA MARIE (RICHARDSON) JACKSON, A BELOVED WIFE, MOTHER, SISTER, AUNT, GRANDMOTHER, AND COUSIN WAS PEACEFULLY CALLED HOME ON MONDAY, MAY 6, 2024, SURROUNDED BY HER LOVED ONES.

ADA WAS BORN NOVEMBER 14, 1944, IN ARCOLA, NORTH CAROLINA. SHE WAS THE FIRST OF SEVEN CHILDREN BORN TO FREDERICK AND ESTELLE ALSTON. SHE GRADUATED FROM JOHN R. HAWKINS HIGH SCHOOL IN WARRENTON, NORTH CAROLINA.. ADA MOVED TO BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS IN 1963 TO START WORKING TO REUNITE WITH HER SIX SIBLINGS IN HOPES OF PROVIDING THEM WITH A BETTER LIFE. AFTER THE UNEXPECTED PASSING OF HER MOTHER ESTELLE.
