Whatever Bhagwan does is always beneficial. His wish alone is my prārabdha. He alone is my liberator.

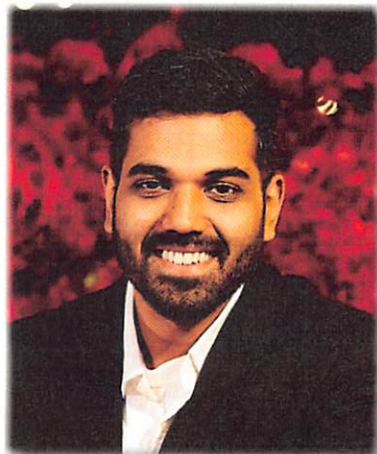
Mahant Swami Maharaj further writes in shloka 152:
