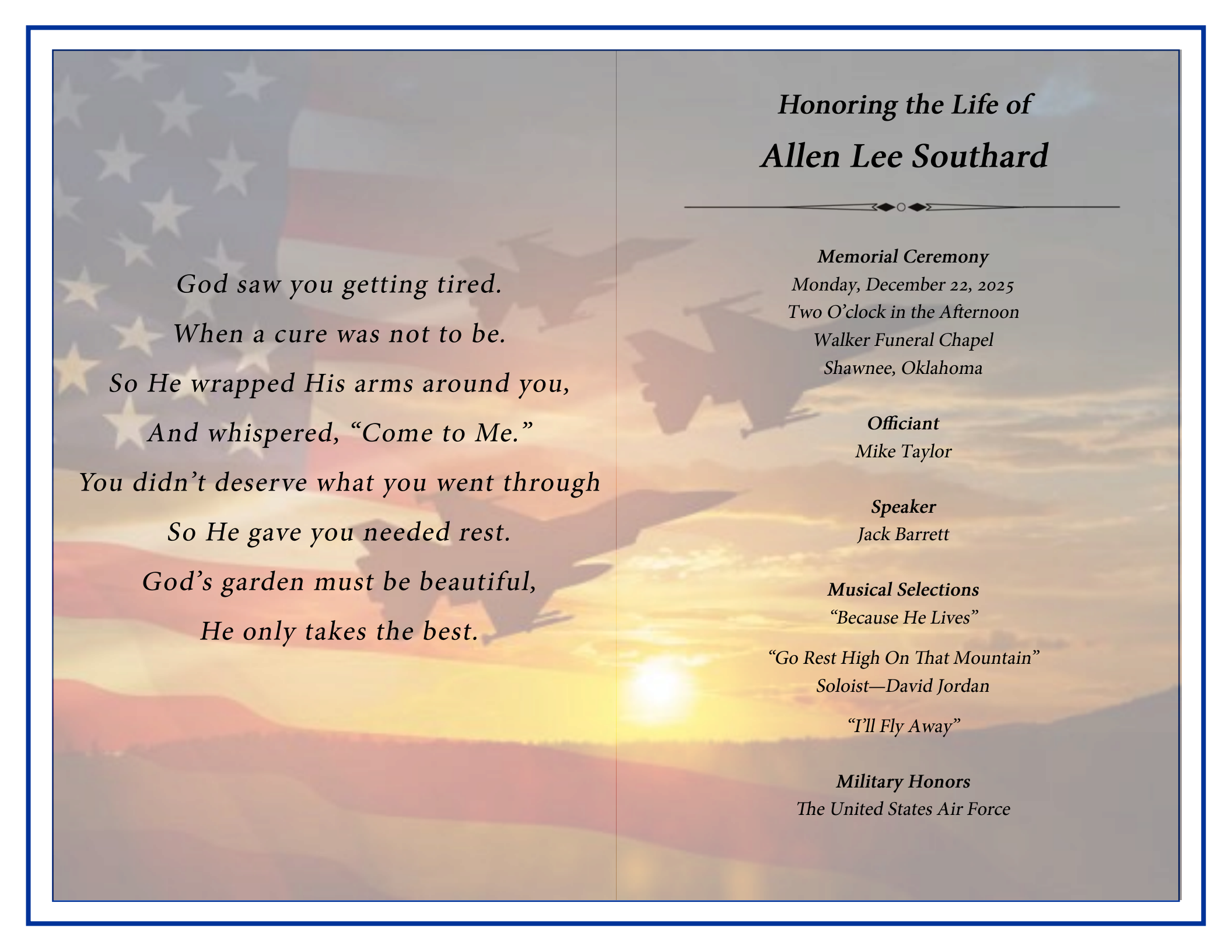
Allen was preceded in death by his parents and a son, James Southard.
