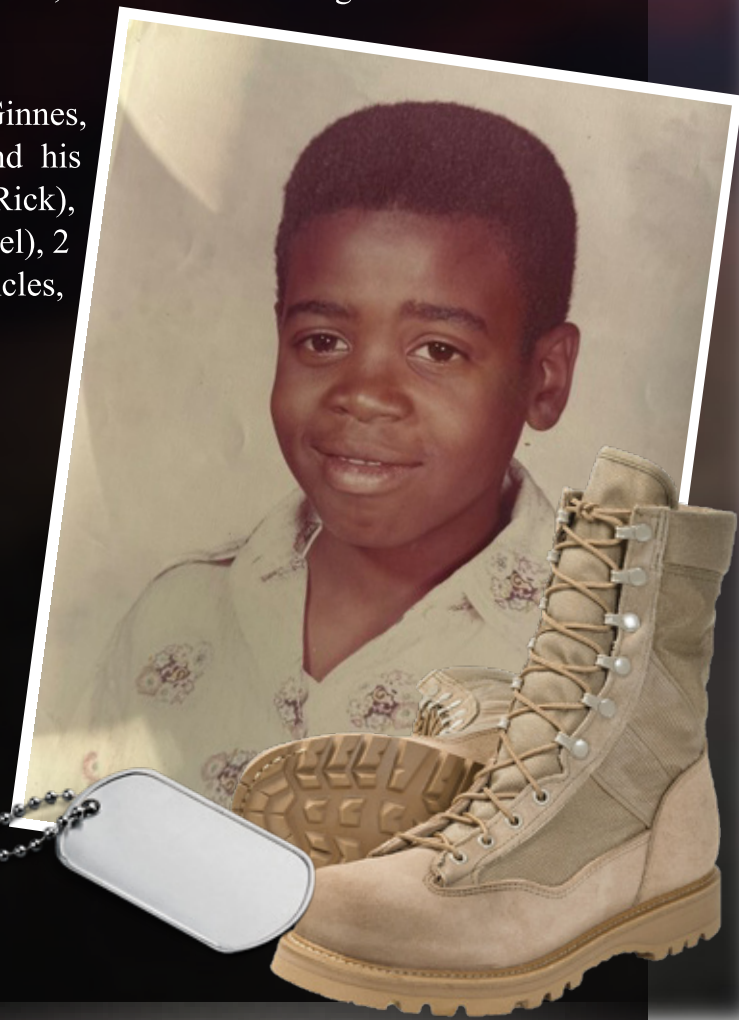

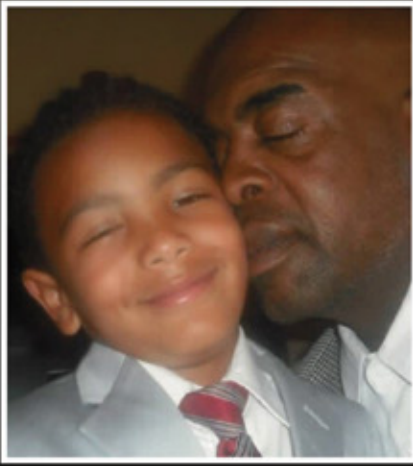
Mr. Dorin LYNDWELL MCGINNES

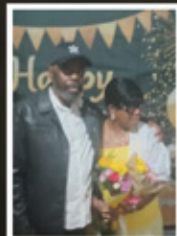
