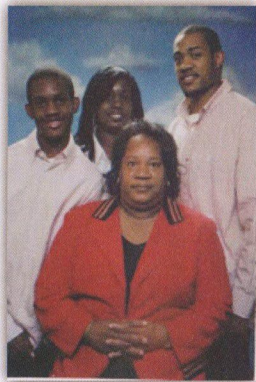


*Fill not your hearts with pain and sorrow,
