

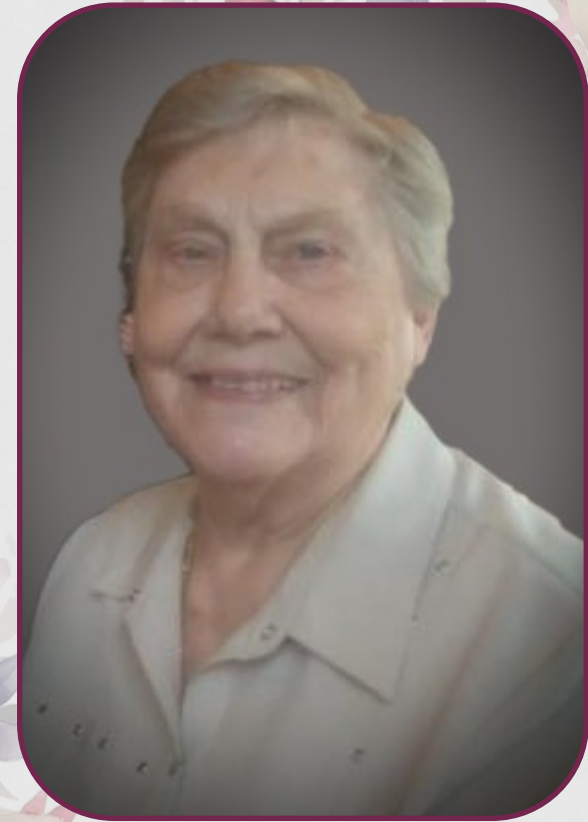
Psalm 23
