so shall we ever be with the Lord.



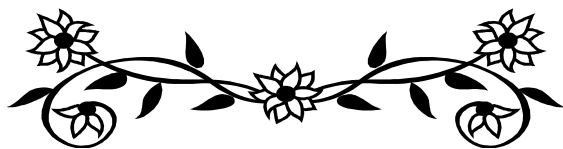
