REFLECTIONS OF LIFE

CHARLES EDWARD DICKEY was born April 29, 1955, in Tallahassee, Florida, to Franklin Dickey, Sr. and Fay Lee Jones Dickey. Charles was the second of five children, and the first of the five to pass. He was preceded in death by his daughter, April Dickey; and his mother, Fay Lee Jones Dickey.

CHARLES was employed with the City of Tallahassee for 35 years. He was a Foreman II in Facilities, assigned to the Department of Parks and Recreation. A devoted member of St. Phillip African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church, he faithfully served in several ministries. He sang in the Men’s Choir, was a member of the Sons of Allen, and he also served as a Steward and a member of the gospel group, the Spiritual Messengers. **CHARLES’** passion was cooking and fishing. He was regarded as a master of grilling. For several years, he also had operated a successful catering enterprise.

CHARLES enjoyed telling jokes, watching western television shows, fishing on the lake, and hunting deer. He believed wealth was not measured by material possessions, but by how much one helps others in need.

On May 14, 1994, he married the former Marilyn Plummer, and from this marriage he gained **four children**: Tawana (Harry) James, Anthony T. Plummer (*deceased*), Chadwick D.
