To My Son

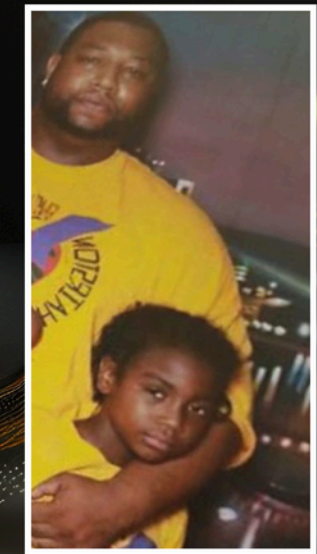
