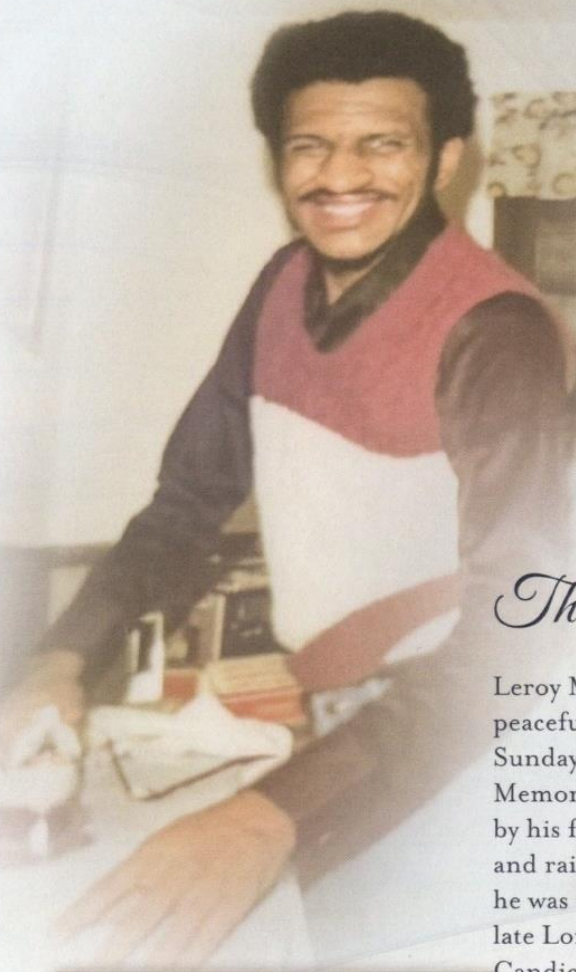

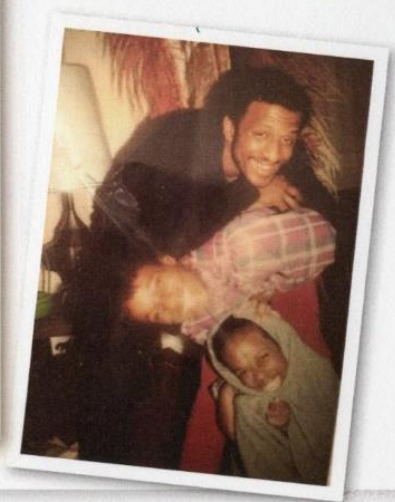

## *The Obituary*

Leroy Michael Williams, 76, peacefully passed away on Sunday, May 10, 2026, at Paoli Memorial Hospital, surrounded by his family and friends. Born and raised in Coatesville, PA, he was the beloved son of the late Lorenzo Williams, Sr. and Candice Juanita Alston Williams.



For 55 wonderful years, Leroy shared a devoted marriage with his wife, Johanna Rudolph Williams, a partnership filled with love and mutual respect. He was a 1969 graduate of Coatesville Area Senior High School. Leroy dedicated over three decades to his career at Embreeville State Hospital. Even after retirement, he began a new career as a security guard at Norristown State Hospital and later at Brian's House.

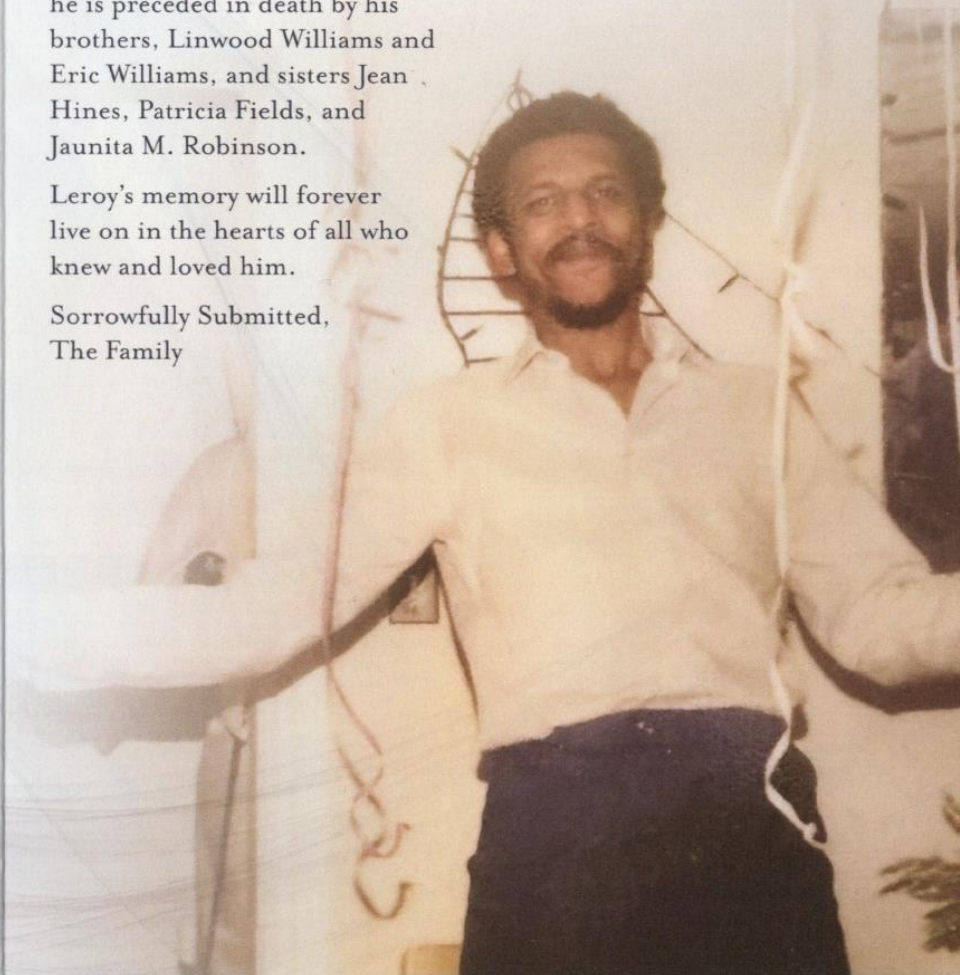
