Her Story

Zandruck May Chin, was born on May 22, 1939, in Clarkstown, Trelawney, Jamaica. She was the 5 of nine children born to Felix & Edith Hines. Zandruck who is lovingly remembered by her family and all who knew her, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 26, 2026, surrounded by her loved ones.
