

Bruce Ray Jorgensen, of Fargo, passed away peacefully on Monday, August 10, 2026, at the age of 71, following a courageous two-and-a-half-year battle with cancer. 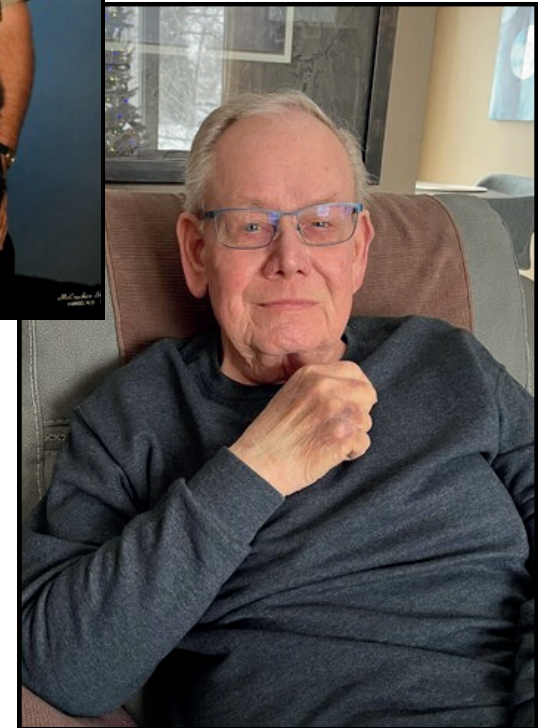
Bruce was a member of the car club formerly known as the Red River Mopars, a current member of Valley Vintage Car Club and the North Dakota Street Rod Association.
